

## The Alliance Transplant Leadership Council

### CHARTER

#### **Alliance mission:**

The Alliance is the recognized leader within the organ donation and transplantation community dedicated to providing engaged learning, innovation and collaborative leadership for future advancements in organ donation and transplantation.

#### **Purpose:**

The Alliance Transplant Leadership Council will work to promote engagement of transplant centers as critical partners in the donation and transplantation community by examining and addressing issues relevant to transplant center performance and advancement. The Council, sponsored by the Alliance, will advance transplant center professionals' efforts to end deaths on the national organ transplant waiting list.

#### **Principles:**

- Define the role of the transplant center community as a key partner in the donation process
- Contribute content for engaged learning opportunities to optimally engage the transplant center community
- Develop and provide resources for transplant centers to improve process and performance
- Encourage the use of sound quality improvement strategies to improve transplant center processes

#### **Activities/Scope of Work:**

1. Collect perceptions from the transplant center community to identify issues to address and propose actions to improve transplant center processes and outcomes
2. Review agendas for Alliance offerings to assure that content aligns with transplant center processes and is relevant for today's transplant center professionals
3. Communicate with the other Alliance Leadership Councils to maximize collaboration and reduce overlap of activities
4. Suggest topics and assist with development of content for the Transplant Center Webinar series
5. Monitor, and revise as appropriate, award criteria that accurately and meaningfully recognize transplant program performance
6. Monitor, update and promote the Transplant Quality Resource Guide and Tools and other resources developed, as a best practice resource for transplant centers across the nation

#### **Duties:** Strategy; Planning; Fiduciary

The Transplant Leadership Council members serve as expert resources in guiding projects and activities, and making recommendations to the Alliance Board of Directors and other national organizations as deemed appropriate to ensure alignment with the Alliance mission and strategic priorities.

Members are expected to bring current information from their constituent group, assist in developing Council priorities and support the implementation of adopted initiatives. In addition to attending meetings, members may be called upon to provide leadership and assist with other councils, special projects, studies, events and other related activities.

**Expected Outcomes:**

- The Council will serve as a catalyst for increasing participation in the Alliance offerings by transplant centers
- Improving relationships between and among transplant centers, the Alliance and other national organizations
- Clarifying performance indicators upon which award criteria are based
- Creating resources and providing education to support transplant centers in their transplantation work
