Purpose:

As the number of older patients and younger, chronically ill patients referred for kidney transplantation continues to rise, transplant centers are faced with the challenge of determining which of these patients are appropriate candidates for transplantation. Medical evaluations help guide clinicians in their decision-making, but can sometimes fall short in determining risk of poor outcomes. The use of a frailty assessment in the pre-transplant setting can help identify candidates at risk for increased graft loss and mortality.
