Hospitals are the vital link between donation and a successful organ transplant. Without the support of a hospital and its staff, OPOs could not facilitate the gift of life. That being said, the advocacy of a hospital "Donation Champion" can significantly impact the success of donation through positive influence and counseling of their peers. By investing their time and efforts, Donation Champions create a culture of donation that draws institutional attention to the best practices associated with organ donation. During this webinar, we will dissect the "anatomy" of a donation champion and discuss the ways in which a champion can grow into their role. Additionally, we will identify ways to promote awareness within the hospital and local community through activities most commonly coordinated through a Donation Champion.
