### Purpose:

Preparing for adulthood is tough enough for the next generation of young adolescents facing a fast-paced world. As their bodies change, so do their medical needs and other social pressures that come with maturity. In the pediatric transplant population, failure to address these longitudinal issues could impact patient outcomes and quality of life. Join us to hear from Dr. Maria Díaz-González de Ferris, Professor of Pediatrics and Director of the UNC Healthcare Transition Program, on how they have addressed these issues by implementing a patient-centered program called **STARx (Self-management and Transition to Adulthood with Rx=treatment)**. The STARx Program accommodates the specific clinical and social needs of the pediatric transplant patient population as youth prepare to self-manage their health and transfer to adult-focused health services.
